“What does Self-Help do?”

The Family Self-Help Program is here to help people who choose to go through the legal system without the benefit of an attorney.

“Where is the Self-Help Program located?”

The Self-Help Program is operated telephonically out of every Courthouse in the Circuit. See the phone numbers above.

“What type of cases can the program help ME with?”

The kind of cases they can help you with are, a DIVORCE or ENFORCE A COURT ORDER, or a STEPARENT ADOPTION or a NAME CHANGE for you or your child or family. You can MODIFY your Final Judgment, or get TEMPORARY LEGAL CUSTODY OF A RELATIVE.

“Where do I go to get the forms I need?”

Forms and pre-printed legal documents can be purchased from the CLERK OF COURT / FAMILY DIVISION in every Courthouse in the circuit. The packets vary in price.

“Can Self-Help give me legal advice?”
